1. **Nyetimber Classic Cuvée** - England £75.00

Red Wine

ARGENTINA

14. **Sottano Malbec, Mendoza** £42.00
Intense aromas of red and black fruit, with wonderful spices of white pepper and clove.
15. **Tannat, Bodega Nanni, Cafayate Valley** £49.50
Violets and blueberry on the nose, then substantial and meaty on the palate.
16. **Malbec Opalo, Maurico Lorca, Uco Valley** £59.50
Notes of violet and berry fruits backed up with the meaty bass notes; the hallmark of excellent Malbec.

AUSTRALIA

17. **Heilan Coo, Shiraz Mataro, Victoria** £39.50
A well-bred wine dripping with plum and chocolate flavours. The Mataro adds a depth and subtle spice notes.
18. **Angus the Bull Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Victoria** £50.00
Ripe black fruits with rich dark chocolate and vanilla in smoky oak aromas. Medium to full bodied palate weight, characterised by attractive tannins and a savoury masculine finish.
19. **Soul Growers Defiant Mataro, Barossa Valley** £80.00
Spice, structure and depth of flavour will ensure Mataro will enliven your soul!
20. **Yalumba, The Signature Cabernet Shiraz, Barossa Valley** £85.00
A bold wine with great length, powerful dark fruit and menthol hit.

CHILE

21. **Santa Digna Merlot Reserva, Central Valley** £39.50
A very attractive and elegant Merlot with great aromatic intensity of plums and blackberry jam. Chocolate and sweet spices contribute to a long finish.

LEBANON

22. **Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley** £100.00
Kirsch and plums follow through to the palate with blackcurrant and chocolate. The tannins are velvety soft and this wine has a lot of depth and fruit concentration with a long finish.

FRANCE

23. **Andre Cologne Beaujolais Villages, Beaujolais** £45.00
The fresh and mouth-watering nose is bursting with crunchy red fruit and sweet spice, backed up by a touch of pear drop and strawberry.
24. **Fleurie Millesime Cave de Fleurie** £47.50
This wine is bursting with ripe berry fruit flavours. It is soft and fresh, with delicate light powdery tannins.
25. **Chateau Macquin, Saints-Georges-Saint Emilion, Bordeaux** £55.00
Full-bodied with concentrated flavours of cassis, raspberry and tobacco with a lifted acidity. Silky tannins linger on the long, persistent finish.
26. **Domaine Belleville Rully Rouge Chapponniere, Burgundy** £88.00
Crammed with bright, vibrant fruit: red berries abound, with more complexity emerging as the wine opens up in the glass.
27. **Gigondas 'Romane Machotte,' Amadieu, Rhone** £90.00
Succulent cassis, black cherry and wild berries dominate on the nose along with hints of thyme, black olives, and woodsmoke from the oak ageing.

28. **Benjamin Leroux Gevrey Chambertain, Burgundy** £135.00
The palate is medium bodied with sappy red fruit, firm grip, fine depth with a crisp finish.

ITALY

29. **Ormanni Chianti, Tuscany** £49.50
Classic and classy Sangiovese led red with cocoa dust, cherry tarts and violets.
30. **Bibi Graetz Casamatta Rosso, Toscana** £54.00
This is a medium-bodied, juicy red that offers plenty of dark red fruit in an accessible style underpinned with a bright accent of acidity.
31. **Villa Belvedere Amarone della Valpolicella, Veneto** £69.50
A rich, complex, wine. It is full-bodied, and the flavours are of plums, blackberries and raisins.
32. **Corino Giovanni di Corino Giuliano Barolo, La Morra** £105.00
On the nose, aromas of nutmeg and clove mingle with lemon peel and yellow flowers. On the palate notes of lime and stone-fruit are complemented by a touch of salinity and mouth-watering acidity.

SOUTH AFRICA

33. **Springfield Estate, The Work of Time, Robertson** £62.00
Deep and concentrated on the nose, it opens on the palate to reveal crisp fresh cassis fruit with smoky edges and a hint of green pepper.

34. Syrah 'The Pack' Painted Wolf, Swartland £64.00
Savoury with juicy dark berry fruit, smoked ham, white pepper spice and hints of smoky oak. With ripe tannins and vibrant acidity, this Syrah is medium-bodied with a layered finish.

35. Creation Pinot Noir, Walker Bay £72.00
Fragrant red berries, vanilla and wood spice on the nose. The palate is elegant with raspberry and hints of earthy mushroom supported by supple tannins.

SPAIN

37. Damano 5 Tinto Ribera del Duero, Castilla y Leon £42.50
Dark and intense, with aromas and flavours of blackberries, black cherries and creamy notes of vanilla. A rich, medium-bodied red with an excellent finish.

38. Marco Abella Loidana, Priorat £57.50
This wine offers intense aromas of fruits, strawberry, cherry, raspberry and black cherries; with hints of blue flowers, cedar and spices.

39. Bodegas Urbina Seleccion, Rioja £60.00
A velvety and complex wine that boasts flavours of ripe berries, vanilla and toasted oak.

40. El Escoces Volante Dos Dedos de Frente, Syrah, Catalunya £79.00
On the palate, it is rich and deep without being overbearing. It has mouth-watering acidity, ripe tannins, and elegant oak integration and a precise fruit expression.

USA

41. Chateau Smith Cabernet Sauvignon, Washington State £65.00
Aromatic, classic and refined Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich cassis fruit, dark spices and hints of graphite and pencil shavings gives way to a long satisfying finish.

42. Clos du Val Cabernet Sauvignon, California £92.00
The colour is a deep garnet and the wine has aromas of black fruits, cedar wood, dark chocolate and leather.

White Wine

SPAIN

70. Sauvignon Blanc 'Nube', Leza Garcia £39.50
Tropical aromas of pineapple and passionfruit leading to a crisp mouthfeel and refreshing finish.

71. Bodegas Navajas Blanco Crianza, Rioja £41.50
Delicate, fresh and intriguing taste yet ripe and warm at the same time.

72. Domingo Martin Albarino, Rias Baixas £44.00
Rich and generous flavours of ripe peaches and pears, backed by vivid lemon and mineral acidity. A well-balanced wine with a fresh finish.

CHILE

73. Emiliana 10 Gewurztraminer, Cachapoal Valley £42.50
Floral and fruit notes, leaving a sweet sensation with a delicate acidity.

FRANCE

74. Sauvignon Blanc Haut-Poitou, Sauvion £42.50
Just north of Poitiers lies this relatively new appellation. It offers more tropical fruit compared to a Sancerre, but still the same elegance and lifted herbaceous aromatics.

75. Domaine Bott-Geyl Reisling, Les Elements, Alsace £59.50
Clear, ripe and concentrated stone fruit bouquet and nicely clear and dry finish.

76. Domaine de la Chezatte Sancerre, Loire £60.00
This wine is bright and refreshing, with aromas and flavours of lemon, lime and apple, with a subtle mineral note and a mouth-watering finish.

77. St Cosmé Little James Basket Press, Sauvignon Blanc Viognier, Rhone Valley £60.00
Aromatic and zingy Sauvignon Blanc is combined with rich and floral Viognier to create a wine with lots of juicy fruit.

78. Pinot Gris Famille Hugel Classic, Alsace £64.00
Rich, ripe and fruit-driven with notes of honey and roasted pistachio, apple pie and a touch of cream and spice.

79. Domaine Christian Bellang Mersault, Burgundy £100.00
Classic Meursault rich, fruity and toasty oak on the nose. On the palate think butter, rich fruit flavours and buttered toast.

GERMANY

80. Peth Wetz Estate Riesling, Rheinhessen £48.00
A dry Riesling with a delicate fragrance of white peaches, apricot and juicy pears. Classic Rheinhessen, both in expression and style.

NEW ZEALAND

81. Hunters Reisling, Marlborough £49.50
Crisp, zesty and dry with apple, tropical fruit and lime flavours.

82. Greywacke Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough £65.00
Yellow-fleshed peaches, rock melon and blackcurrant alongside lemon icing, chamomile and hints of rose petal.

83. Kumeu River Estate Chardonnay, Auckland £79.50
The enticing nose offers ripe citrus and a hint of smoke. This is concentrated and deep, with lovely, fresh acidity and a crisp, saline finish.

AUSTRALIA

84. Torbreck Woodcutters Semillion, Barossa £62.00

This medium bodied style offers delicate scents of lime and lemon, traces of bees wax, and toasted brioche.

85. Josef Chromy Chardonnay, Tasmania £67.50

Bright grapefruit and nectarine flavours with subtle hints of walnuts. Rich stone fruit flavours on the palate with a fresh citrus finish.

86. Penfolds Bin 311 Chardonnay, Tumbaramba £82.00

It exhibits lemon and lime aromas and a mineral acid backbone, complemented by barrel fermentation and maturation in seasoned oak. Minimal filtration is employed, preserving elegant fruit flavours.

ITALY

87. Castillo di Tassarolo Gavi 'Spinola' Piemonte £46.00

Fantastic breadth and aromas of lime, orange blossom, flowers and greenage.

88. Zensa Fiano IGP, Puglia £44.00

The wine is straw yellow in color and displays delicate aromas of lemon-lime, peach, almonds and honeysuckle.

89. Alois Lagedar Porer Pinot Grigio, Trentino-Alto Adige £67.50

Fresh and fruity with melon and peach flavours, and a touch of spice and minerality.

AUSTRIA

90. Gruner Veltliner, Niederosterreich £39.50

Spicy aromas of citrus, green apples and pepper, medium body with a harmonious spiciness, pronounced fruitiness on the palate.

SOUTH AFRICA

91. Waterkloof Circle of Life White, Stellenbosch £42.00

Citrus and lemon flavours with slight peachy notes on the nose. A tight mineral core and creamy middle palate allows for great complexity and a persistent finish.

92. Rocking Horse Cape White Blend, Western Cape £56.00

A layered and complex nose with aromas of kiwi fruit, mace, apple skin and yellow flowers. The palate is tight and rounded with a honeyed texture and a long, almost saline finish.

93. Roussane 'The Pack', Painted Wolf, Paarl £60.00

A wonderfully enticing wine with layers of lime, apple, apricot and blossom along with a fresh herbaceousness on the nose.

94. Newton Johnson Albarino, Walker Bay £64.00

Ripe limes, tangy nectarine and quince fruit is softened with a mealy beeswax character. Drifting scents of apple blossom and honeydew deliver some alluring top notes.

95. Leeu Passant Chardonnay, Stellenbosch £135.00

On the nose, aromas of nutmeg and clove mingle with lemon peel and yellow flowers. On the palate, notes of lime and stone-fruit are complemented by a touch of salinity and mouth-watering acidity.

Rosé Wine

NEW ZEALAND

105. Esk Valley Rosé, Hawkes Bay £39.00

Aromas of strawberry and red fruits predominate with a hint of spice.

SOUTH AFRICA

106. Pinotage Rosé, Delheim, Stellenbosch £42.00

A classic dry rosé revealing the elegant side of Pinotage with a light salmon pink colour, a bouquet of fresh strawberries and orchard flowers.

FRANCE

108. Chateau d'Eclans Whispering Angel, Provence £65.00

Elegant cool precision with easy going open and attractive fruitiness.

Dessert Wine & Port

109. Luis Felipe Edwards Late Harvest Viognier Sauvignon Blanc, Chile (37.5cl) £23.00

Complex and sweet with notes of peach, citrus, honey and oak.

110. Royal Tokaji Late Harvest, Hungary (50cl) £52.50

Delicious complexity and richness, with characters of fresh and dried apricots, orange blossom and runny honey.

111. Chateau Laville Sauternes, Bordeaux £95.00

Hints of pear, mandarin zest and apricots. Overall, it has a rich, honeyed palate of lovely citrus fruit with a syrupy texture.

112. Quinta do Vallado 10yr Tawny Port, Portugal (50cl) £67.50

This has rich nutty, dried fruit aromas and luscious, sweet raisin, mocha chocolate, spice and date flavours on the palate.
